SUMMARY	
Point 2	<p>The ENTSOs are still working on the 2024 TYNDP draft report, therefore, their internal working groups for the 2026 TYNDP process are not set up. As soon as the chairs are defined a first meeting between the chairs of the WGs of the SRG and those in the ENTSOs can be organized. It is important that the work is aligned so that the SRG can give the best input into the development of the 2026 scenarios.</p> <p>WG1: first meeting took place on 28.3.2024. First step is to define the scope of the work in this WG. Key issues are: timeline of stakeholder engagement in the next months, to discuss the storylines especially with the topic of “economic variances”.</p> <p>WG2: First meeting took place on 5.3.2024. First discussion on the scope of the work. The WG2 wants to help in collecting statistical data on heating and on national demand to feed the ETM (energy transition model), which is the base for the demand calculations. On 13.4.2024 a deeper look into the ETM will be done to familiarize the members with the tool. Next steps: workshop with the designer of the ETM Quintel to understand the logic within the tool. Followed by the discussion on the reference year. All members are asked to deliver data available to them to feed the demand calculation with the most recent data. This will support also the national TSO to set up their national trend models.</p> <p>WG3: the kick-off meeting was postponed to the following week, because not enough WG3 members joined the meeting.</p> <p>WG 4: the kick-off meeting will be scheduled in week 16</p>
Point 3	<p>Two organizations applied to be SRG members: EASE (European Association for Storage of Energy) and Open Energy Transition (Think tank/software company specialized in energy planning). The process according to the ToR is ongoing.</p>
Point 4	<p>Publication of the 2024 TYNDP results will take place in mid-May after the board of the ENTSO’s has voted on them. Workshop to present the 2024 results and the start of the 2026 TYNDP process is discussed for the second week of June.</p> <p>The necessity of the weekly meetings was discussed. It is decided that they are continued to ensure the information flow between different WGs and all members are informed. The weekly meetings will be reduced to 30 minutes. Next invites for the following weeks will follow.</p>
