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SUMMARY	
Point 2	<p><b>WG1:</b> the last meeting took place on 23.4.2024. The main topic was the discussion on the different types of uncertainties, and the influence of economic developments/uncertainties and how to include them into the storylines. The work within the ENTSOs on the 2026 has not yet fully started, as first the 2024 scenario reports need to be finalized. For the next meeting of the WG1 on 15.5.2024 a presentation of the ENTSOs with their first discussion points is planned.</p> <p><b>WG2:</b> A list of working-priorities regarding demand and EV modelling was shared with the members to be discussed and decided in the next meeting. At the beginning of May, a meeting is planned with the ETM specialists from the ENTSOs to give the WG members the opportunity of . A list of detailed questions on the calculation mechanisms is currently compiled to prepare for the meeting. It is crucial do understand the assumptions and calculations used within the ETM before the WG can start to discuss potentially necessary changes for the TYNDP 2026 modelling. Next meeting of WG2 is on 3.5.2024.</p> <p><b>WG3:</b> The list of relevant topics for WG3 extracted from the 36 proposals that SRG produced as the feedback to 2024 TYNDP process was discussed to define the key priority topics for WG 3. Six topics have been identified that are the most important for the storylines. They will be discussed in the next WG meeting and the group will decide, which of them shall they be working on. The list will be checked with other WG for overlaps to avoid double work.</p> <p><b>WG4:</b> The Kick-off meeting took place on 18.04.2024. First step is to understand how CO2 management is included in the modelling suite and the scenarios. The group will collect questions to be shared with the ENTSOs. The topics of interest encompass, among others, the inclusion of CO2 management aligning with EU policies, especially the newly published material</p>
Point 3	<p><u>Replacement of existing members:</u> the motivation letter for the replacement within SmartEn – Lucy Yu replaces Marcia Poletti – was distributed to the members. According to the ToR, the application of a substitution of an existing member is approved after 1 week, if no objections are voiced from the SRG members.</p> <p><u>New members application:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Open Energy Transition applied as a new member. As defined in the ToR, ACER and the European Commission are asked for approval of new members. If no objections are raised until 23.4.2024, the application is approved.</li> <li>• Pending is the application of the European Association for Storage of Energy (EASE), where questions regarding a potential conflict of interest between the association work and the SRG were discussed with the convenors. The convenors will follow-up on their application.</li> </ul>
