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Summary

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| Point 2 | <p>WG1: The Innovation Roadmap is not yet ready to be shared with the SRG, but it is expected to be available in a couple of weeks. The SRG will then have the opportunity to review the proposed list of innovations. A discussion on how many of these innovations can be implemented has also taken place. ENTSOs assessed different innovations based on various criteria, and the SRG could provide feedback on the ranking of these innovations and provide its own ranking based on the criterion how the SRG could contribute to their implementation.</p> <p>Secondly, the possibility of a joint workshop dedicated to the economic variants was discussed. The goal would be to develop a concrete proposal on how these variants are incorporated into the scenarios (this can be presented by ENTSOs). This could be a joint session involving ENTSOs, SRG, ACER, the European Commission, and, if deemed useful, external speakers. Potential dates for the workshop are September 24 or 25, depending on the availability of the participants. A Doodle poll will be circulated to confirm the most feasible date. The workshop will be held in a hybrid format.</p> <p>WG2: No updates. WG3: No updates. WG4: No updates.</p> |
| Point 3 | <p>A simple excel tool will be developed to keep track of the recommendations issued for the 2024 and 2026 TYNDP cycles, as well as those from the Stakeholder Engagement Plan. The tool will list all recommendations and track their outcomes, including how they were integrated. A first draft of this tool will be prepared this week. Bram and Lea will collaborate bilaterally on the tool and report to the wider group during the next weekly meeting. Once the tool is ready, it should be stored on SharePoint.</p> |
