Point 2	<p>Innovation Roadmap Document: The document will be shared on Friday, August 30. It contains a comprehensive list of all requests received, with some of these requests already incorporated into the model. Further discussions on what can be further implemented will also take place.</p>
Point 3	<p>WG1: The Doodle poll to schedule the workshop on the scenario framework and economic variants has indicated that the most feasible date is Tuesday, 24th September, in the afternoon. The workshop will be held in a hybrid format, and those based in Brussels are encouraged to attend in person. The purpose of the workshop is to gather feedback on the economic variants proposed by the ENTSOs.
