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### Summary

Point 2	<p>The workshop was considered very constructive by the participants and lead to a better understanding of the complexity of the parameter setting.</p> <p>The demand team of the ENTSOs will meet on the 26<sup>th</sup> of September, and the supply team on the 1<sup>st</sup> of October to compile a list of parameters and the timeline. In the next step the first parameters will be tested in the models and in parallel the SRG will assess the proposals.</p>
Point 3	<p><u>WG1:</u> Innovation roadmap: the ENTSOs innovation roadmap sub-team is currently analysing the feedback of the SRG to the draft innovation list. Missing innovations were added to the list, as well as the consideration of the ESABCC comments. The ENTSOs team works on the ranking of the innovations and asks the SRG to rank in parallel as soon as possible. The overlying target for any ranking should be the positive effect an innovation has on the quality of the scenarios that are used to plan the infrastructure. The SRG will receive the latest update of the innovation list with more detailed explanations for further discussion at the next WG 1 meeting on the 1<sup>st</sup> of October 2024.</p> <p><u>WG2:</u> A meeting is planned between the ENTSOs, the chairs of WG2 and a representative of Quintel on the 27<sup>th</sup> of September 2024 to discuss the details of the reference data update.</p> <p><u>WG3:</u> No update</p> <p><u>WG4:</u> The ESABCC was invited to the WG4 to discuss their advice on the 2024 scenarios with the focus on the carbon budget calculations. Main topic was the accounting methodology of fossil and biogenic CO2 emissions.</p>
Point 4	<p>GIE has applied for a change of representative, the official process has started and the SRG was informed.</p>
