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Summary

Point 2	Change in representation of GIE has been approved.
Point 3	<p>WG1 meeting on Oct 2nd, 2024. ENTSOs presented an updated list of innovations with additional information on the content and the rating. Due to the short timeline the decision was taken, that the SRG will not create a rating system followed by a voting process. SRG members can support the innovation process in two ways: for innovations that are not integrated into the 2026 process, SRG members could develop suggestions to split the innovations into smaller steps that could allow a partial integration into the 2026 process. In addition, a technical input from the SRG members can support the process. For both topics a call for volunteers will be set up as soon as the innovation list is finalized. These volunteers would join the discussions in the internal expert groups of the ENTSOs.</p>
Point 4	<p>The first ETM training of the TSO will take place on 10th of October 2024, followed by a second training at the end of October. Also at end of October the TSOs will be trained in the supply tools of the ENTSOs. The work in the ETM is the first step of the work and the guidelines on how to fill it with data will be distributed. Supply data set collection will start in November. The data collection process for ETM will run until 24th of December 2024. The policy cut-off date for all data is the 31st of December 2024. In January the data will be checked by the ENTSOs versus the national and European targets.</p> <p>The detailed timeline is currently updated and will be distributed to the SRG to plan the interaction between SRG and the ENTSOs.</p>
Point 5	<p>WG2: Meeting of Chairs WG2 with ENTOS and Quintel do discuss the reference data. The ENTSOs have taken the decision that the reference year will stay 2019, but with a potential update with available data. WG2 will deliver proposals to Quintel for the update of statistical data for residential and non-residential buildings. Gas and electricity DSOs (the latter via the EU DSO Entity) will be informed to participate in the national scenarios' planning processes</p> <p>WG3: A workshop on the use of flexibilities for the operation of heat pumps is planned together with WG2. Additional proposal to organize a workshop on Biomethane together with the advisory board of the ESABCC to discuss the most recent results of the developments in the member states.</p> <p>W4: no update</p>
