| Point 2 | <p><u>WG1</u>: Innovation Roadmap: the ENTSOs will organize a workshop once the innovation roadmap is done. ENTSOs are planning to provide documentation on the high-level framework and scenarios. SRG will be able to comment before the public consultation.</p> <p><u>WG2</u>: Planning to contribute to WG3 meeting about flexibility from heat pumps. A review is planned of load projections. Gave feedback on ETM reference data, which Quintel now should integrate, to the extent possible in the given timeline.</p> <p><u>WG3</u>: Meeting planned on 30/10 at 10:00. Agenda is to coordinate next steps on heat pump flexibility, hydrogen/biogas and installed generation capacity (wind, solar) in coordination with WG2.</p> <p><u>WG4</u>: No update.</p> |
| Point 3 | <p>After the workshop, it remains unclear how the Commission Reference Scenario will be aligned with the TYNDP. The timelines don't match. Installed capacity data points seem to not align. ENTSOs are discussing options to coordinate with the Commission. It would be good to ensure assumptions are not contradictory, and ENTSOs need and want to understand the data properly, for the sake of transparency.</p> <p>SRG considers coordination very important, as also recommended in the set of recommendations by the SRG on the TYNDP 2024/2026.</p> <p>Commission indicated an interest to share more with the wider community. It is therefore important to show interest.</p> <p>Final results will be published with a creative commons license.</p>         |
