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Summary

Point 2	<p><u>WG1</u>: No updates neither from the group, nor on the Innovation Roadmap by the ENTSOs, meeting moved to following week (6.11.) due to unavailability of many participants.</p> <p><u>WG2</u>: No meetings. The group will need to work on demand projections for transport considering different sectors. Feedback will be needed from ENTSOs also considering DSOs' projections. For the 2026 cycle electricity and gas system operators in each country will need to agree on a single scenario (and respective ETM) for demand projections in all sectors based on policy targets in the NECPs. It could be useful to consult projections by different stakeholders analysing such topics.</p> <p><u>WG3</u>: Decision to coordinate on topics to explore further. There are many issues related to flexibility that the group needs to discuss, but this requires a better understanding of how especially the gas system is modelled in terms of flexibility in the ETM and Plexos models. Next step should be to organise a meeting with ENTSOs where they should explain how flexibility is now modelled in the TYNDP and how the different flexibility resources are modeled into the detail. In that context, projected installed capacities of renewable generation with data from relevant stakeholders should also be discussed.</p> <p><u>WG4</u>: No updates.</p>
Point 3	<p>The list of the SRG members involved in different WGs needs to be updated, in order to include people that have replaced initial SRG members and alternates. New WG participants should indicate their expertise and topics they would like to contribute in the respective excel sheet on sharepoint.</p>
