Summary

Point 2	<p>WG1: met on the previous day to review their work plan and identify next actions. The initial focus of the work will be on the economic variants framework. WG1 also plans to review the draft questions for the ENTSOs' public consultation, which is planned for June 2025, ahead of their release. It was noted that having a visual representation of the governance structure of ENTSOs working on the TYNDP would enable the SRG to engage more effectively and align its work accordingly. The next WG1 meeting is planned for two weeks from now.</p> <p>WG2: progressing with the organisation of a workshop on heat pumps, which is planned in February (exact date – TBC). The workshop will explore the existing technology and the treatment of heat pumps in the ETM and Plexos. It was noted that WG3 should also participate, given the relevance of this topic to their work. Additionally, WG2 is waiting to hear back from the ENTSOs on innovation of EV modelling.</p> <p>WG3: the next meeting is planned on 23rd January at 10:00, with an agenda to follow soon. Also, WG3 is looking to identify a date for hydrogen discussions, according to the availability of ENTSSOG.</p>

STAKEHOLDER REFERENCE GROUP FOR THE TYNDP SCENARIOS

	WG4: looking to focus its efforts on the Innovation Roadmap, specifically on how the carbon capture value chain can be integrated into the process through innovations in this cycle.
Point 3	The workshop on the Innovation Roadmap has been set, scheduled to take place on 28th January 10:00-12:00. This will be an online workshop, with invitations to be sent by the ENTSOs.
Point 4	As discussed last week, the ToRs require revision to address the issue of membership for associations representing gas DSOs. During this process, it was noted that other elements in the ToRs require an update, to better reflect the reality of the SRGs work and clarify membership duration and selection. These points will be addressed through a single update to the ToRs. The SRG co-convenors are developing proposed amendments, and these will be presented to the entire SRG in the coming weeks for discussion. The voting process will be organised after that.
Point 5	SRG members were informed that the European Commission has formally approved the 2024 TYNDP scenarios, by a communication sent to the ENTSOs on 14th January 2025. This means no further steps are required in the scenario development process. That being said, the ENTSOs aim to undertake two follow up actions: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Clarify the issue on GHG emissions, which was raised by the ESABCC. This may be done through an additional publication by the ENTSOs (format tbc) 2. Improve data visualisations for the final product.
Point 6	The location for the informal meeting tomorrow has been decided, as reflected in the virtual invite.
