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Summary

Point 2	<p>Deadline to send objections about the replacement of EASE's representative in the group is 5 March EOB.</p>
Point 3	<p>WG1: Meeting yesterday discussing the TYNDP 2026 timeline. ENTSOs now primarily focused on the central scenario. The Innovation Roadmap has been published. The WG thinks it would be good to discuss the gap filling methodology at the end of April. Also, that the SRG can have a look at the public consultation questions (coming in May – July) beforehand so by mid-May.</p> <p>The other workshops on carbon pricing should be organised by WG2 and WG3, but the exact plans and dates need to be clarified and announced. Finally, the WG recommend that DSO representatives engage more actively in the SRG discussions as they had started doing towards the end of the 2024 cycle.</p> <p>WG2: Main takeaways from the workshop on the demand forecasting tool and the heat pump CO2 calculations were shared. Many thanks for the inputs provided by WG members. Bilateral meetings with WG members on EV modelling can be organised, if anyone is interested, WG chair should be contacted.</p> <p>WG3: As discussed in WG1 yesterday, the WG3 will discuss in its next meeting a possibility to organise relevant workshops on carbon pricing, also considering the availabilities given by the ENTSOs. All WGs will be invited to these workshops.</p> <p>WG4: On 13 March the WG has a meeting with the ENTSOs and ESABCC to discuss open questions regarding carbon pricing methodology and its ties with the Innovation Roadmap and to what extent it is possible to move towards a more detailed discussion about CCS/CCS. Next step will be a WG meeting to discuss the ENTSOs questions. Towards the end of April there will be another workshop where the ENTSOs will present the outcomes of these discussions.</p>

Point 4	Some SRG members suggested to create an informal document (for instance an Excel file) that brings together different inputs and feedback by the SRG members provided during the various technical workshops. This can serve as a basis in case the group decides to issue any SRG recommendation later, that may also require putting in place a voting. This can also serve as a tracking file to monitor actions that were suggested and how the group or the ENTSOs took them forward. It should be accessible by all WGs. A potential template that could be used was presented and it will be circulated after the meeting to get feedback (and added in the Sharepoint). The same file could be used to transfer action requests from the ENTSOs to the SRG and to track all relevant interactions. Open topics – for which not all SRG members agree on the same action – will still be tracked to ensure follow up and that a decision is taken whenever relevant.
Point 5	WG representatives from the SRG organisations keep changing. There is a file in the SharePoint where organisations can indicate their points of contact and automatically this updates the mailing list of the WGs. SRG members are invited to check if the file has been correctly updated in their case.
Point 6	Reminder about the forthcoming TYNDP webinars and workshops by the ENTSOs: Update on the TYNDP (6 March) and Public stakeholder workshop (27 March). SRG to give a presentation in the second and the inputs will be discussed in the next weekly meeting.
Point 7	Reminder that the next weekly meeting will be longer because ENTSO-E will present the ONDP and ongoing work in this matter.
