## Summary

Point 2	<p>WG1: The WG discussed about having a joint WG discussion on the data used for the TYNDP. Request to all WG members to contribute to a document under preparation about the Innovation Roadmap – deadline 1<sup>st</sup> April, information shared by email today. In its next meeting the WG will discuss all received inputs (meeting planned on 8 April).</p> <p>WG2: Workshop about EV modelling assumptions planned for 28<sup>th</sup> March, all SRG members invited. The ENTSOs will present how they have considered the previous recommendations by the SRG on this matter. A dedicated WG2 meeting on flexibility from heat pumps and industrial flexibility overall will be planned. This links also with the work of the WG3 that has already started working on heat pump flexibility, both workstreams should be aligned. The suggestion is to organise a joint WG2+3 meeting on the matter, most probably in the last week of March or first of April.</p> <p>WG3: The WG discussed about organising a survey among SRG members on how different organisations and actors are using the TYNDP data including stakeholders at national level. Reminder that the 2019 data are not correct.</p> <p>WG4: The WG discussed with the ENTSOs about the carbon budget methodology and the limitations in their work. The ENTSOs need advice on sources to find non-energy related emissions, for example industrial emissions, process emissions and how they can be extrapolated to the future. Also, on how CCS and CCU could be implemented in the different sectors and could actually contribute to reduce emissions (so that these contributions are realistically simulated in the scenarios). The ENTSOs also explained how these points are now taken into consideration and calculated. The WG will try to collect relevant information and provide a qualified quantification for the role of CCU/CCS in the scenarios. WG chair will clarify whether also the non-energy CO<sub>2</sub> emissions are calculated in other non-energy processes for instance agriculture, industry.</p>
