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Summary

Point 2	<p>WG1: The WG discussed TYNDP data. The SRG feedback document on the Innovation Roadmap was shared with the WG. The document has three sections: the commentary on the Innovation Roadmap overall by the SRG, the SRG feedback on the process to develop the Roadmap by the ENTSOs, the SRG comments on the content of the suggested innovations.</p> <p>SRG members asked to provide feedback in tracks and changes by 1st April.</p> <p>WG2: On Friday the WG has a workshop on EV modelling where ENTSOs will explain the current modelling approach and discuss with the WRG assumptions and parameters. The objective is not to discuss about changing the methodology but to check together assumptions and parameters.</p> <p>WG chair reached out to some external relevant stakeholders like Transport&Environment for relevant feedback. The WG also discussed about flexibility, but the potential might be very different from one industrial sector to the other. ENTSOs do not seem to differentiate this appropriately in the modelling, but the WG chair got in touch with the respective contact at ENTSO-E to clarify how this is currently done. ENTSO-E will check if possible, for the WG to provide its input to the Innovation Roadmap about EV modelling one week later, so that the WG has time to go through the workshop discussion on Friday and prepare its input.</p> <p>WG3: WG3 has two workshops next week, one on hydrogen and synthetic fuels (Thursday morning) and one on CO2 commodity prices (Friday morning). The WG 2 and 3 chairs had a meeting on Monday about flexibility and are trying to figure out how to proceed operationally with this discussion in the SRG. The respective contact within ENTSOs has suggested to organise a workshop where they can explain the methodology currently used.</p> <p>WG4: No update as the WG convenor was not present.</p>
