Point 2	<p><i>Input presentation from Artelys</i></p> <p>Artelys presented the scope of the study commissioned by ACER on the TYNDP process, which was followed by a discussion with SRG members.</p>
Point 3	<p><i>Update from the working groups</i></p> <p><u>WG1</u>: A meeting previously took place to reflect on SRG input to the Innovation Roadmap. The next meeting, taking place on April 30, will be the occasion to work on an enhanced feedback document based on the comments of the members. A suggestion was made to add a discussion on economic variants and high-level framework on the agenda of the next meeting. In addition, a workshop on the gap filling methodology with the ENTSOs is in preparation and will likely take place on the 5 or 6 of May. SRG Members will receive an invitation.</p> <p><u>WG2</u>: Input has been shared to ENTSO-E on EV modelling. A document is being prepared on demand projections, based on which the group will meet to discuss.</p>

	<p><u>WG3</u>: The workshop on import potentials, which had to be rescheduled, is currently in planning to agree on a new date. A date could be found at the end of April, which would allow to take into account the input from the SRG in the consultation. The group is waiting to hear back from the ENTSOs about the deadline for the SRG to provide input to the hydrogen modelling methodology and about the follow-up workshop to be organised. The next meeting, for a which a date has not yet been settled, will be focused on the workshops.</p> <p><u>WG4</u>: The input prepared by the group on the questions covered in the previous workshops has been sent to the ENTSOs.</p>
Point 4	<p><i>Siemens Energy expressed interest in joining SRG</i></p> <p>An express of interest to join the SRG was received from Siemens Energy. Since Siemens is already a member of T&D, it was recommended that both organisations should coordinate to explore synergies, keeping in mind the possibility for all SRG members to have an alternate. The SRG will be kept updated.</p>
Point 5	<p><i>AOB</i></p> <p>In the following week, SRG convenors and WG chairs will meet to discuss internal processes for a better alignment across WGs. The outcomes of the discussion will be shared with the group.</p> <p>A request was made to ENTSOs to share the PID document, which had been requested a month ago.</p>
