Summary

Point 2	<p><i>SRG membership – welcome to a new representative of 4 gas DSO associations</i></p> <p>As announced in the previous week, the representative of the 4 gas DSO associations has been replaced. The new representative was welcomed into the group.</p>
Point 3	<p><i>Update from the working groups</i></p> <p>WG1: A meeting took place the same morning, with a focus on advancing the recommendations on the Innovation Roadmap. WG 2-4 chairs will be invited to revise the document soon. Following this, all SRG Members will have the opportunity to give their own feedback in the upcoming weeks.</p> <p>There will be a dedicated session to discuss the questions prepared by the ENTSOs for the public consultation will take place on Tuesday, 20 May, at 3pm. All SRG Members are invited to participate. In view of the timeline, the ENTSOs will be able to incorporate SRG feedback into the consultation questions that will be launched on June, 12.</p> <p>The next regular WG meeting will take place on Wednesday 14 May, at 9:30.</p> <p>Lastly, the gap filling methodology will likely be discussed in a regular meeting or in a separate session, but the date and modalities are still to be determined with the ENTSOs.</p> <p>WG2: The input previously provided to the ENTSOs on EV modelling will go through a voting process within the SRG. It was proposed to finalise the input in the second half of May. A communication will be sent to SRG members to proceed to the voting. A question was raised on the voting process, which will include voting on the recommendations individually with three options: in favour, against or abstaining.</p> <p>Lastly, it was shared that any SRG member having interest in becoming the second WG2 co-chair should communicate it. An email will be circulated to inform all members.</p> <p>WG3: A workshop took place on hydrogen and ammonia methodology on the previous Monday. The material, including slides and recording was circulated. SRG input is to be submitted by May 9 to the ENTSOs. The details will be discussed in the next scheduled WG3 meeting in the following week.</p> <p>WG4: No substantial updates were announced.</p>
