Summary

STAKEHOLDER REFERENCE GROUP FOR THE TYNDP SCENARIOS

Point 2	EFET and SmartEn resign as SRG members due to lack of capacities.
Point 3	Joni pulled together a list of open points to address in the draft opinion on the 2026 cycle. Will circulate with the SRG. As Joni is leaving, the coordination of the file will be taken over by Andrzej. Deadline for acting on the open points is the SRG meeting of 25/2. The plan is to add a few points on future areas to explore on the demand side and flexibility, heat pumps and data centers.
Point 4	ENTSOs plan to give an introduction to the upcoming central scenario data set in the following SRG weekly meeting. Not clear yet when the data itself will be shared with the SRG.
Point 5	ENTSOs would like to hold a public workshop to kick off the 2028 cycle. Agenda etc. to be defined, possibly with the SRG. No additional public consultation planned on 2026 results. ENTSOs will share results before publication. Benchmarking results will be discussed in a “to be planned” workshop.
