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Summary	
Point 2	The Terms of Reference update remains open for voting. As of the meeting, 12 of the 17 votes needed for quorum had been submitted. Members who had not yet voted were reminded to do so before the deadline the following Monday.
Point 3	The TYNDP Scenarios Report, previously expected on 21 May, has been postponed to 8 June due to internal delays and voting procedures at the ENTSOs. The ENTSOs shared a first draft of the scenarios report chapter referencing stakeholder engagement, including the SRG's contribution, for review ahead of the meeting. No major concerns were raised on the content shared by the ENTSOs. One discrepancy was noted around the treatment of "storylines": the SRG's opinion piece had stated there was no separate storylines process in the current cycle, whereas the ENTSOs' chapter suggests economic variants were considered as part of storylines development. This is seen as a lesson learned on aligning terminology going forward. The topic will be discussed further next week, when ENTSO colleagues join the meeting and a possible updated version of the chapter may be available.
Point 4	The previously shared dates for the 2028-cycle kick-off workshop are no longer expected to hold. The ENTSOs are expected to join next week's meeting with a revised proposal covering both the kick-off workshop and a possible dedicated workshop on the Innovation Roadmap; it remains to be clarified whether the two would be combined or held separately. Ahead of that, SRG convenors met with working group chairs to discuss possible topics for the kick-off workshop, drawing on the earlier member survey of interests and expertise. A list of eight candidate topics was circulated, with the names of members who volunteered to lead discussion on each noted alongside. Cross-cutting topics such as the Innovation Roadmap and regulatory implications were considered relevant to all SRG members and were not tied to a single lead, but will be kept in view during discussions with the ENTSOs. Members were invited to propose additional topics, provided they are also willing to take the lead on preparing and presenting them. The list remains open and its feasibility will need to be discussed with the ENTSOs once their revised plans are known.
Point 5	An update on the Innovation Roadmap will follow next week once the ENTSOs have coordinated internally.
