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Summary

Point 2	Voting on the updated Terms of Reference closed on Monday. 20 votes were submitted, exceeding the quorum of 17, and all votes were positive, meaning the updated Terms of Reference is approved. Next steps are to add the official approval date to the document and to ask the ENTSOs to publish it on the website. Separately, and related to this point: the Terms of Reference provide that SRG convenors are elected at the start of each new TYNDP cycle. With the TYNDP scenarios opinion submitted and the 2028 cycle approaching, conveners and working group chairs have begun discussing a process for electing convenors for the next cycle. This will be discussed with the full SRG at the meeting on 3 June, with more information to follow.
Point 3	The scenario-building working group held a physical meeting last week. A minor two-week delay to delivery of the scenario package was confirmed, driven by additional checks to ensure the report is complete, consistent, and robust – not by any change to the underlying results, which remain as shared with SRG in April and have already been handed over to the respective TYNDP teams. The revised timeline: working group approval of the report this week (the day after the meeting), final updates completed by 29 May, ENTSOs' board and System Development Committee approval in the week of 1–5 June, and publication on 8 June. The publication date itself is unchanged and on track. The draft chapter referencing SRG's stakeholder engagement, shared previously, was briefly discussed with no comments raised. Members were reminded that the deadline for feedback on this chapter is Friday, 22 May.
Point 4	With the scenarios report delayed, the previously circulated dates for the kick-off workshop are considered out of date. The ENTSOs proposed splitting the kick-off into two events: an SRG-only workshop in early summer, focused on timeline input and lessons learned to help plan the 2028 cycle in more detail, followed by a separate, public official kick-off workshop in autumn (September/October). A new Doodle poll with updated, closer dates for the SRG-only workshop was circulated in the chat, replacing the earlier, now outdated spreadsheet of dates. Members were asked to complete it so planning can begin. The session is expected to be hybrid, with a preference discussed for an online, half-day format (the Doodle currently shows a full day due to a poll licensing limitation, which the ENTSOs will look into adjusting). The previously shared list of candidate topics and volunteer discussion leads for the kick-off workshop was recirculated in the chat for members who may not have seen it.
Point 5	No dedicated Innovation Roadmap workshop is currently planned for June, contrary to an earlier email; the ENTSOs were not aware of such a plan and do not believe it is feasible on that timeline. Prioritisation of innovations for the next cycle could instead be included as a topic within the SRG-only summer workshop. ENTSO-E will follow



	up on this with the colleague who sent the original email once she is back from holidays.
Point 6	Next week's SRG weekly meeting has already been cancelled. The group will reconvene on 3 June.
